

- I will not be admitted to class until I have complied with all regulations concerning registration and tuition payments, and I am personally responsible for my financial obligation to Paris College of Art or its duly-authorized partner institution.
- Students in the PCA/Emerson Global BFA Program may not violate rules, regulations, or policies of either institution or either institution's host country while they are studying on that campus. In the event that either institution determines, using the same policies and procedures applicable to all students on that campus, that a PCA/Emerson Global BFA Program student has violated the rules, regulations, or policies of either institution, that institution may, after consulting with the other institution, terminate that student from the Program or put the student on disciplinary probation. In the event of a conflict between the rules, regulations, or policies of PCA and Emerson, the rules, regulations, or policies of the institution where the violation occurred will govern, in compliance with local regulatory and legal frameworks.
- Students dismissed for disciplinary reasons are ineligible to receive tuition refunds.
- I am responsible for familiarizing myself with and adhering to the rules and regulations outlined in the Student Handbook. A download of the Spring 2019 handbook is available in the Orientation portal; the Fall handbook will have be available during Orientation.
- The school reserves the right to suspend or dismiss any student who, in the judgment of the administration, does not maintain the required standards of scholarship, or whose attitude or behavior does not conform to the ideals of the school.
- By enrolling at Paris College of Art I grant permission to Paris College of Art to maintain relevant personal information for the duration of my enrollment (e.g. transcripts from prior schools, financial and medical information, bio data, and addresses) or indefinitely (e.g. academic records that PCA requires to issue transcripts), as needed. I have been informed that I can withdraw this consent at any time by notifying the institution in writing. I understand that if I withdraw consent for the institution to keep my educational records, PCA will not be able to provide transcripts in the future or to in any other way document my educational experience at PCA.
- Paris College of Art reserves the right to take or cause to be taken, photographs, films or videos, and other graphic depictions of students, faculty, staff and visitors for promotional, educational, and/or noncommercial purposes, as well as approve such use by third parties with whom the university may engage in joint marketing.
