Dear members of the PCA Community,

In light of the resurgence of COVID-19 infections in France and across Europe, the French government has decided to implement new lockdown measures in order to limit the spread of the disease. Many businesses including universities, restaurants and bars will be closed and a certain number of restrictions on movement will be put in place.

For the members of our community this means that we will switch to on-line instruction and that the campus will close Thursday at 8 pm, so please pick up whatever materials or work you may need before that time. Your department chair will contact you with instructions on how to attend or teach classes on-line.

I understand that this is very short notice, and if you are not able to come to campus on Thursday, we can exceptionally allow authorized students, faculty and staff to access campus on Friday between 9 am and 6 pm.

Starting on Friday morning, you will need a self-declared authorization (*autorisation de sortie*) to move around the city. We will provide details and English-language links as they become available from the government.
