Following the French President's announcements yesterday the Prime Minister spoke today and his comments regarding the possibility for technical institutions of higher education requiring access to specific materials and workshops to offer classes on campus leave some hope that we will be able to maintain some studio classes on campus. This is just a hope at this stage and needs to be confirmed with the relevant authorities. We are working on that and will provide an update as soon as we are in a position to do so.

There is no need to email me with requests for updates, as I will be addressing the entire community as soon as I have new information to share.

Starting tomorrow, you will need to complete an "exemption certificate" every time you leave your house. You can find a version in English attached and also [here](#).

I also recommend that you download the AntiCovid app (there exists a version in English) that has a link to a form that you can complete on your phone rather than printing out a separate one each time you leave your house.

For those needing to come to campus tomorrow to pick up materials or work, campus will be open between 9 am and 6 pm, and you will need to complete the attached certificate and check the first box.
