Dear Members of the PCA Community,

The French President spoke last night to announce changes to the current restrictions in place, and here are the highlights to help you plan your daily lives:

- The requirement to complete a certificate every time you leave home remains in place until December 15th
- Starting this Saturday (November 28th), you will be able to move about for 3 hours in a 20 km radius for your daily physical activity. Small shops and places of worship will re-open.
- Starting December 15th, movie theaters, theater and museums will reopen and you can travel freely within France, but there will be a curfew between 9 pm and 7 am (with the exceptions of the nights of December 24th and 31st)
- New measures will be announced at the end of January, depending on the evolution of the number of daily infection rates after the holidays.

We recommend that you download the *TousAntiCovid* app if you have not already done so. There is an English language version and you can use it to generate certificates and to track infection rates. You should also continue to practice good habits such as frequent hand washing and regular ventilation of indoor spaces. If you experience any symptoms of illness stay at home, isolate, and contact your medical provider.
